PROPOSED RECREATION AREA, TENNIS COURT, AND POOL AREA GUIDELINES

At the April 18, 2019 Board Meeting the Board was required to rescind the 2017 Revised Recreation Area, Tennis Court, and Pool Area Guidelines due to never being formally adopted with a vote of the membership.

Therefore, the Board of Directors has requested a vote of the homeowners on the enclosed Recreation Area, Tennis Court and Pool Area Guidelines. The Board has approved all three of these Guidelines—the Associations Bylaws require that they also be approved by the membership to make them effective. At least one-hundred and sixty-eight (168) affirmative votes are needed to pass.

It is imperative that you vote, by mail, or in person at the November 21, 2019 meeting at 7:00 p.m. at the Turtle Rock Community Center, 1 Sunnyhill, Irvine. The ballots were mailed out mid-September. If you misplaced your ballot and need a new one, please contact Management to request one.

COYOTE INFORMATION

Many residents of Irvine express concerns about coyote sightings and the consequences of predator animals within the urban setting. Some animal owners have lost their pets to these skilled hunters because many are not aware of recent coyote activity in the area.

There are many steps that can be taken to protect you and your property from nuisance wildlife to include coyotes:

- Do not feed coyotes.
- Fence off animal enclosures (fully enclose if possible).
- Keep cats and small dogs indoors or in the close presence of an adult.
- Feed pets indoors.
- Store trash in covered heavy duty containers with secure lids.
- Keep yards free from potential shelter such as thick brush, weeds, wood piles, or excess debris.
- Enclose the bottoms of porches and decks.
- Eliminate potential food and water sources, such as, fallen fruit and standing water.
- Keep your property well lit at night.
- Put your trash out the morning of pick up.
- Motion sensitive sprinklers may be effective in areas of high concern.
- Keep small children under close adult supervision at all times.

PATIO HOMES

Home improvements require approval for exterior changes **prior to the start of work**; this includes front yard landscape changes. Homeowners may choose to collect the signatures of neighbors on the Neighbor Awareness Form accompanying the Architectural Application, *but* their signatures do not constitute approval. It is a courtesy to your neighbors to make them aware of your intentions. The Architectural Application can be found on the Turtle Rock Glen website under Architectural Information.

Any improvements/changes made without approval of the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) are subject to fines and removal of improvements at the homeowner's expense.

MAKE ROOM FOR YOUR CAR

An abundance of cars parked in the driveway or cluttering the streets is not a desirable look for any community. The Associations CC&R's require homeowners to use their garages for the purpose of parking automobiles or storing an Owner's household goods. No storage In the garage shall be permitted which precludes the use of the space of such garage for the parking of at least one automobile. We would also like to remind you to keep your garage doors closed when not in use.

PARKING

Turtle Rock Glen streets within the Patio Homes section are City of Irvine streets. Parking over 72 hours is not permitted. Overnight parking of a commercial vehicle more than 84 inches across is not permitted. If you notice these violations, please record license plate and vehicle description and contact Irvine Police at 949-724-7200. Garden Homes and Townhome streets are private and have their own parking rules.
