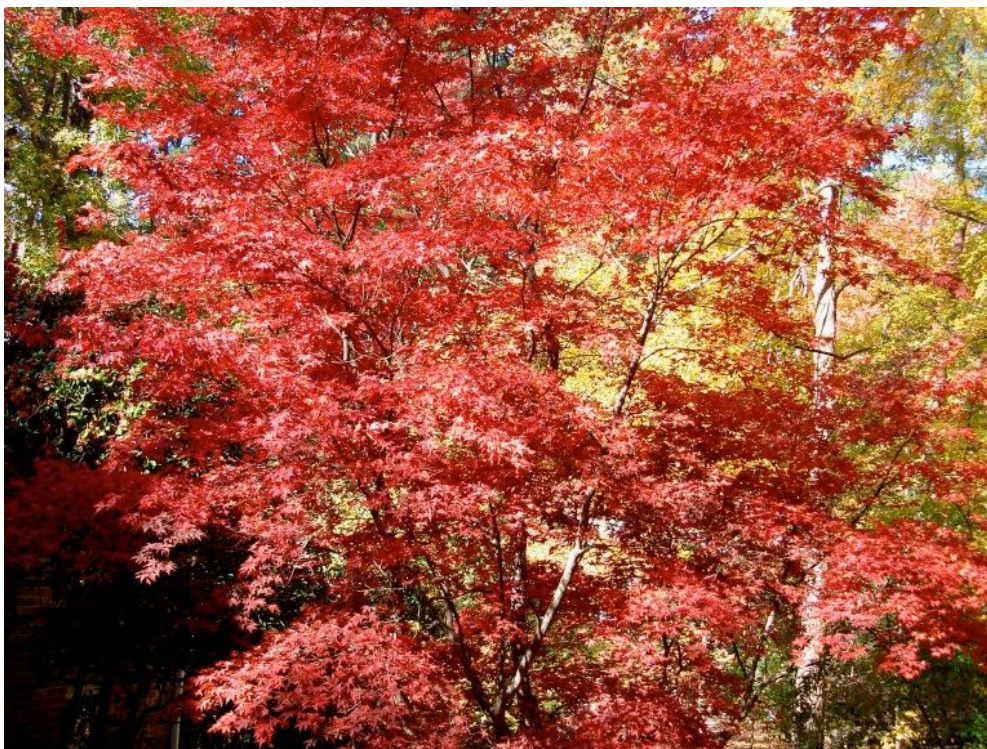


## Recommended Trees for Rear Yard/Patio Area

In an ongoing effort to help members of our community, the Board of Directors has asked our landscape contractor for a comprehensive list of recommended trees for planting in confined areas. The list provided is not all-inclusive and there are many others to choose from, however, please note that to prevent property damage to nearby improvements, homeowners are responsible for ensuring that all landscape material within their yard/patio area is periodically thinned, pruned, cut, trimmed or replaced as necessary.

Homeowners are financially responsible for all damage to buildings, fencing, hardscape, sewer lines or other utilities caused by roots, branches or limbs of trees or shrubs planted within their patio/yard areas, it is important to choose plant materials and planting locations carefully.
